A. Jesus is holy and that changes Everything

Key texts: Matthew 4:18-20; Luke 5:1-11

Acts 2:21[CSB] Then everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved

B. Jesus is trustworthy even when I doubt

Key text: Matthew 14:22-33

Isaiah 41:10 [CSB] Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you; I will help you; I will hold onto you with my righteous right hand.

C. Jesus is forgiving even when I sin

Key texts: Luke 22-31-34; 54-62, John 18:15-18, 21:1-19

Colossians 1:14 [CSB] In Him we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

D. Jesus is worth following even when it gets tough

Key Text: Acts 3:1-4:24

Acts 4:12 [CSB] There is salvation in no one else, but there is no other name under heaven given to people by which we must be saved.

E. Jesus is worth following even when it gets tough

Key Text: Acts 10

Acts 10:43 [CSB] All the prophets testify about him that through his name everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins. **Matthew 4:18-20 [ESV]** While walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon (who is called Peter) and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea, for they were fishermen. ¹⁹ And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." ²⁰ Immediately they left their nets and followed him.

Matthew 14:28-33 [ESV] And Peter answered him, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water." ²⁹ He said, "Come." So Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water and came to Jesus. ³⁰ But when he saw the wind, he was afraid, and beginning to sink he cried out, "Lord, save me." ³¹ Jesus immediately reached out his hand and took hold of him, saying to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" ³² And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased. 33 And those in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

Acts 4:1-3a [ESV] And as they were speaking to the people, the priests and the captain of the temple and the Sadducees came upon them, ² greatly annoyed because they were teaching the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection from the dead. ^{3a} And they arrested them and put them in custody

Acts 10:44-48 [ESV] While Peter was still saying these things, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word. ⁴⁵ And the believers from among the circumcised who had come with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit was poured out even on the Gentiles. ⁴⁶ For they were hearing them speaking in tongues and extolling God. Then Peter declared, ⁴⁷ "Can anyone withhold water for baptizing these people, who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?" ⁴⁸ And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to remain for some days.
