Big Idea: Encouragement is the fuel that resets community.

Study Questions and Application

1. Read Hebrews 10:19-21. How does Christ's finished work shape the way we draw near to God and encourage one another with confidence rather than fear?
2. Read Hebrews 10:22-23. According to these, what happens to faith and hope when believers try to live in isolation instead of community?
3. Read Hebrews 10:24-25. What would intentional, urgent encouragement look like in your everyday relationships this week—at church, at home, or at work?
4. This week, intentionally encourage one person each day—through a word, text, prayer, or presence—reminding them of God's faithfulness and helping them take one step forward in faith.
5. Pray asking God to draw you near to Himself, and to use your words and presence this week to strengthen and encourage others.

[Hebrews 10:19-21] Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter [4:16] the holy places by the blood of Jesus, [9:25]²⁰ by the new and living way that he opened for us [Hebrews 9:8, John 10:9, John 14:6] through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, [9:3]²¹ and since we have a great priest over the house of God, . . . [4:14, 2:17, Zechariah 6:11-13]

[Hebrews 2:17] Therefore he had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

[Hebrews 4:16] Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

[Hebrews 10:22] . . . let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean [Ezekiel 36:25, Hebrews 12:24, 2 Corinthians 7:1, 1 Peter 1:2] from an evil conscience [Hebrews 9:14] and our bodies washed with pure water. [1 Corinthians 6:11]

[2 Corinthians 7:1] Since we have these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from every defilement of body and spirit, bringing holiness to completion in the fear of God.

[Hebrews 9:14] . . . how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God.

[Hebrews 10:23] Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, [4:14] for he who promised is faithful. [11:11, 1 Corinthians 1:9]

[Hebrews 4:14] Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

[Hebrews 11:11] By faith Sarah herself received power to conceive, even when she was past the age, since she considered Him faithful who had promised.

[1 Corinthians 1:9] God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

[Hebrews 10:24] And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, . . . [3:13]

[Hebrews 3:13] But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

[Hebrews 10:25a] . . . not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some. . .

[Acts 2:42] And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

[Hebrews 10:25b] . . . but [let us be] encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

[1 Corinthians 3:13] . . . each one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done.
